MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

WEDNESDAY, 11 FEBRUARY 2015

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Deputy Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **The Deputy Minister of Agriculture, Water and Forestry laid upon the Table:**
Annual Report of the Ministry of Agriculture, Water and Forestry for the year 2013/2014.
3. **The Minister of Finance laid upon the Table:**
 - (i) Annual Report of Namibre for the financial year ending 31 March 2014;
 - (ii) Annual Report of the Road Fund Administration for the period 1 April 2010 to 31 March 2011; and
 - (iii) Annual Report of the Road Fund Administration for the period 1 April 2011 to 31 March 2012.
4. **Ministerial Statements in terms of Rule 89 of the Standing Rules and Orders:**
 - (i) The Minister of Finance reported that due to an urgent meeting to be attended by Members of Cabinet tomorrow, that the Workshop on the Outcome of the Consultations on the *Procurement Bill* that was scheduled for tomorrow, 12 February 2015, is postponed until further notice.
 - (ii) The Minister of Safety and Security invited all Members of Parliament to attend the commemoration of the Namibian Police Day and the Pass out Parade on Friday, 20 February 2015 at Oshakati's Independence Stadium, Oshana Region.
5. **FIRST ORDER READ:**

Reconsideration – *Public and Environment Health Bill* [B.4 – 2014].

The Minister of Health and Social Services moved, seconded by the Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources: That the Assembly now goes into Committee.

The Minister of Health and Social Services moved, seconded by Ms. Jankowski: That the Assembly now goes into Committee.

Agreed to.

ASSEMBLY IN COMMITTEE:

Clause 31 and 32 as amended by the National Council, put and agreed to.

In terms of Rule 69 of the Standing Rules and Orders, Mr. Maamberua registered his reservation to Clause 32 of the Bill.

ASSEMBLY RESUMED:

Bill reported with amendments.

Bill to be referred to H.E. The President for his assent.
