BILL

To appropriate amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2012.

(Introduced by the Minister of Finance)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:

Appropriation of amounts of money for financial requirements of State

1. Subject to the State Finance Act, 1991 (Act No. 31 of 1991), the amounts of money shown in the Schedule are appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2012 as a charge to the State Revenue Fund.

Short Title

2. This Act is called the Appropriation Act, 2011.
