**NOTICE OF A MOTION**

**Mr. Nekundi:**

- (ii) Further *discusses* the Immigration Control Act, 1993 (Act. No. 7 of 1993) in relation to the compliance by the employers and enforcement by the State machineries on the employment of foreign nationals in Namibia both in private and public sectors.
