NOTICES OF MOTIONS:

I. Minister of Home Affairs and Immigration:

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to amend the Citizenship Act, 1990, so as to make clear the meaning of the term “ordinary citizen” in relation to the acquisition of Namibian citizenship by birth of persons who are born in Namibia after the date of independence by fathers or mothers who are not Namibian citizens; and to contradict the recent interpretation of such terms; and to provide for incidental matters.

II. Minister of Industrialization, Trade and SME Development:

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to provide for the promotion of sustainable economic development and growth through the mobilization and attraction of foreign and domestic investment to enhance economic development, reduce unemployment, accelerate growth and diversify the economy; to provide for reservation of certain economic sectors and business activities to certain categories of investors; to provide for dispute resolution mechanism involving investment; and to provide for incidental matters.
