- 2.0 The Chairperson recited the Prayer and Affirmation.
- 3.0 DEBATE ON COMMITTEE STAGE

#### FIRST ORDER READ

Debate on Committee Stage – *Business and Intellectual Property Authority Bill* [B.8 – 2016].

The Chairperson put the question: That she leaves the Chair.

Agreed to.

The Chairperson then called upon the Vice-Chairperson of the Committee of the Whole Council to take the Chair.

The Vice-Chairperson then took the Chair.

Council in Committee:

##### SECOND ORDER READ

Resumption on Debate on Second Reading – *Liquor Amendment Bill* [B.7 – 2016].

Hon. Muha moved, in terms of Rule 51(1)(i) of the Standing Rules and Orders, a motion without notice that the National Council refer the *Liquor Amendment Bill* [B.7 – 2016] to the Standing Committee on Public Accounts And Economy for further scrutiny and that the Standing Committee be mandated to:

1. Review the provisions of Clause 1(2A)(1)(d) of the said Bill and investigate its implications;
2. Scrutinize previous reports dealing with the Liquor Act (Act 6 of 1998);
3. Consult with relevant stakeholders on the Liquor Amendment Bill; and
4. Report its findings, conclusions and recommendations before 20 October 2016 to the House.

The motion was unanimously agreed to.

##### 5.1 THIRD ORDER READ
