**I. Deputy Minister of Finance**

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to amend the Short-Term Insurance Act, 1998, so as to replace the Minister with the Board of appeal as the authority to hear appeals against decisions of the Registrar of staff members; to remove the requirement of a bank guarantee that is deposited by insurance brokers and reinsurance brokers; to increase the minimum amount of the professional indemnity policy maintained by insurance brokers and reinsurance brokers; and to provide for incidental matters.

**II. Deputy Minister of Finance:**

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to amend the Unit Trusts Control Act, so as to replace the Minister with the Board of appeal as the authority to hear appeals against decisions of the registrar; and to provide for incidental matters.

**III. Deputy Minister of Finance:**

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to amend the Long-Term Insurance Act, 1998, so as to replace the Minister with the board of appeal as the authority to hear appeals against decisions of the Registrar or staff members; to remove the requirement of a bank guarantee that is deposited by insurance brokers and reinsurance brokers; to increase the minimum amount of the professional indemnity policy maintained by insurance brokers and reinsurance brokers; and to provide for incidental matters.

**IV. Deputy Minister of Finance:**

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to amend the Medical Aid Funds Act, 1995, so as to replace the Minister of Health and Social Services with the Minister responsible for finance; to replace the Minister with the board of appeal as the authority to hear appeals

against decisions of the Registrar; to provide for administrative penalties; and to provide for incidental matters.
