THURSDAY, 24 NOVEMBER 2016

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

2. **Ms. Jagger laid upon the Table for note-taking:**

Report of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Human Resources and Community Development on the First NACOPAC Stakeholder Engagement Forum on Wildlife Management.

3. **ORAL QUESTION:**

Mr. Mbai (NUDO) asked the Deputy Minister of Works and Transport (No. 22) – *Replied to.*

4. **Ministerial Statements in terms of Rule 98 of the Standing Rules and Orders:**

(i) The Minister of Safety and Security informed the Assembly on the incidents of all illegal possession of fire arms, ammunitions and other war related materials discovered in Police operations and through intelligence gathering from members of the public.

(ii) The Deputy Minister in the Office of the Vice President responsible for Disability Affairs informed the Assembly about the United Nations' International Day of Persons with Disabilities which will be commemorated on 5 December 2016 at the Ministry Gender After School Centre, from 09:00, and invited all Members and the public to attend the event.
